4.4 - Rounding and Arithmetic (3 weeks)

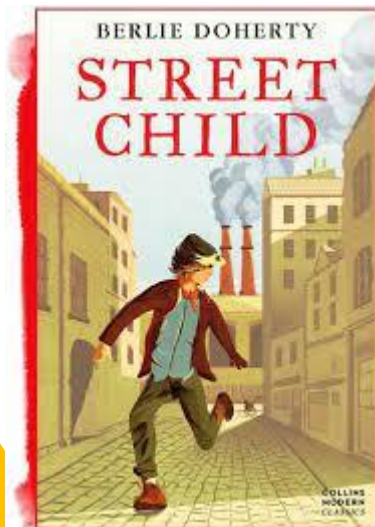
- Rounding to the nearest 10, 100 or 1000

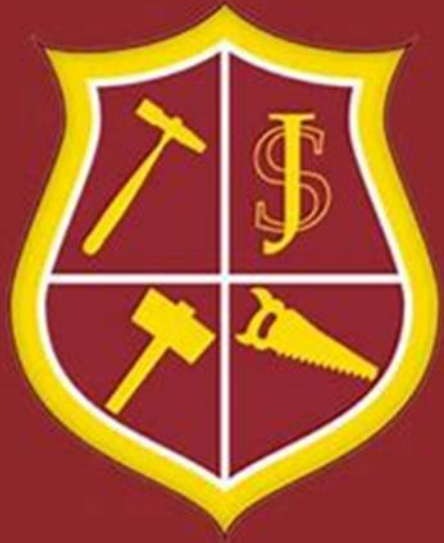
