Article 19 - You should not be harmed and be looked after and kept safe

If your child tells a member of school staff that they have been hurt by another adult or is going to be hurt then that member of staff has a **duty to report** this to the School's Designated Safeguarding Person, Mrs Alexandra Riordan.

The Designated Safeguarding Person will sometimes need to share this information with Cardiff Children's Services for advice and support. You may be informed that this is happening unless advised otherwise by Children's Services.

Please understand that when we do this, we are following the Wales Safeguarding Procedures and not making any judgements about families.

Late pick up from schools - information for parents/carers



Arriving late to collect your child from school can be extremely distressing for them.

You are expected to collect your child promptly at the end of the school day. If there is an occasion where you feel that you may be late in arriving due to traffic etc please can you contact the school office immediately?

If you are regularly late for school pick up, then school will have to address this issue with you. In the first instance we will discuss this with you and endeavour to support you if you are experiencing difficulties. If this continues, we will issue you with a warning letter outlining that regular late picks up will have a negative impact upon your child's emotional wellbeing and if it continues then school will have to follow Local Authority Child Protection Procedures.
