Bug Club:

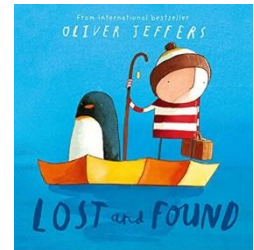
You have been made a log in to access books to read. Please google Bug Club then login.

Literacy:

This week our learning is based on 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers
If you have the book at home share it with your grown up. Alternatively, you can watch it as a film on the internet https://vk.com/video7035628_163325456



- Create/ make an animal from the story and talk about what you are doing with your grown up as you make it. You may choose to build your animal from duplo or stickle bricks, use arts and crafts to create it, paint a picture or use play dough. Get your creative talents flowing!

- Mix a little cornflower and water together. How does it feel? Encourage your child to use words like 'gloopy' 'smooth' and 'silky'. Using your pointing finger, can you write and draw some of these patterns in the mixture? Now have a go at writing your name, or some numbers, or even draw a picture! Remember to be
 - speedy, as your writing will disappear quickly!



- Take a photo of your creature next to your name and email it to us if you can, we would love to see them!

Phonics:

- Copy the sounds that you can hear and say what you can see.
- Can you find 2 objects in your house that start with each sound (s a t p) put the objects in a little bag. Take it in turns to take out an object from your bag, say what the object is and what sound it begins with.
