



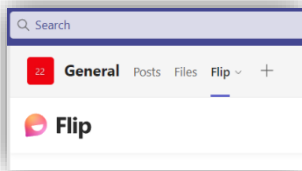

Introducing Reading Progress in Microsoft Teams

Flip and Reading Progress Homework Timetable for 2022-23

Flip is a video discussion and video sharing app. Children are expected to record short video responses to a range of different topics throughout the year. All topics can be accessed by clicking the 'Flip' tab in Microsoft Teams.

Introducing Reading Progress in Microsoft Teams

Reading Progress is a free tool built into Microsoft Teams designed to support and track reading fluency. Students record their reading on camera and submit it to their teacher.

Complete a Reading Progress assignment

Got a Reading Progress assignment due? To complete this assignment you will record yourself reading out loud. It looks just like your other assignments and will show up in your class team's **General** channel and in the **Assignments** tab.

Note: Reading Progress is not supported for guest users. Ensure participants are members of the class.

1. Select **View Assignment**.
2. Select the document under **My work** to open Reading Progress.
3. Ready to read out loud? Press **Start** to begin.
4. You can select the **Immersive Reader** and choose the settings that help you read best.
5. When you finish reading, select **I'm done**.
6. If you'd like, you can review the recording you made. Press **Play** to review your recording.
7. If your educator allowed more than one try, you can choose **Try again** to create a new recording.
8. Select **Use this recording** to attach your recording to the assignment.
9. Don't forget to select **Turn in** to submit the assignment to your educator.
