Here are some suggested activities.

- Make a treasure hunt to find a favourite/lost toy
- Play hide and seek – count to 20!

- Play – I hear with my little ear ..... Something that says ..... quack, quack!
- Fill and empty containers using water/dry materials eg rice/sand/small pebbles – discuss full/empty/half full
- Order items according to size – tallest –shortest/biggest – smallest
- Mark making with implements and fingers. Use different materials eg shaving foam, cornflour and water, sand, flour, rice.
- Use large paintbrushes/rollers and water to wash the wall (up and down movements)
- Make an obstacle course – count how long it takes you to complete it
- Find objects that begin with s (sssssssssss)
- Use old hats, scarves to role play
- Make a den
